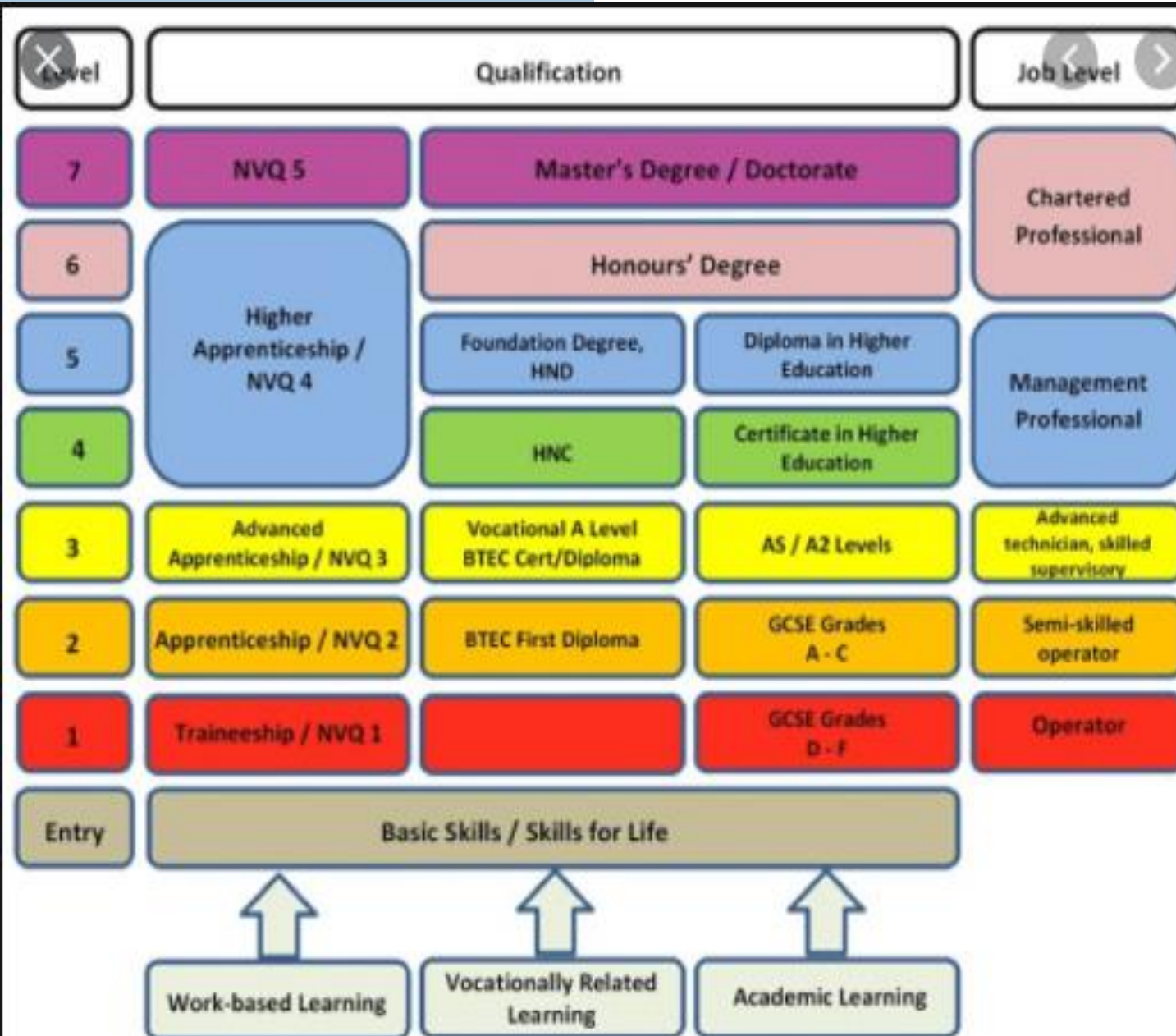

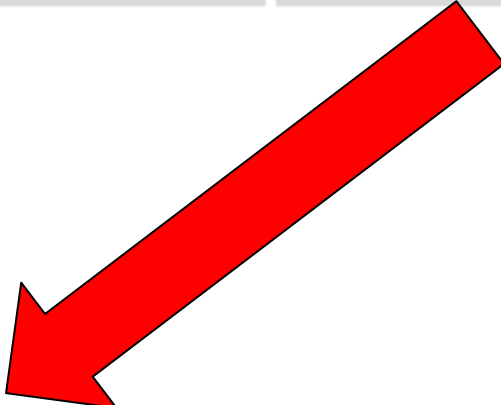
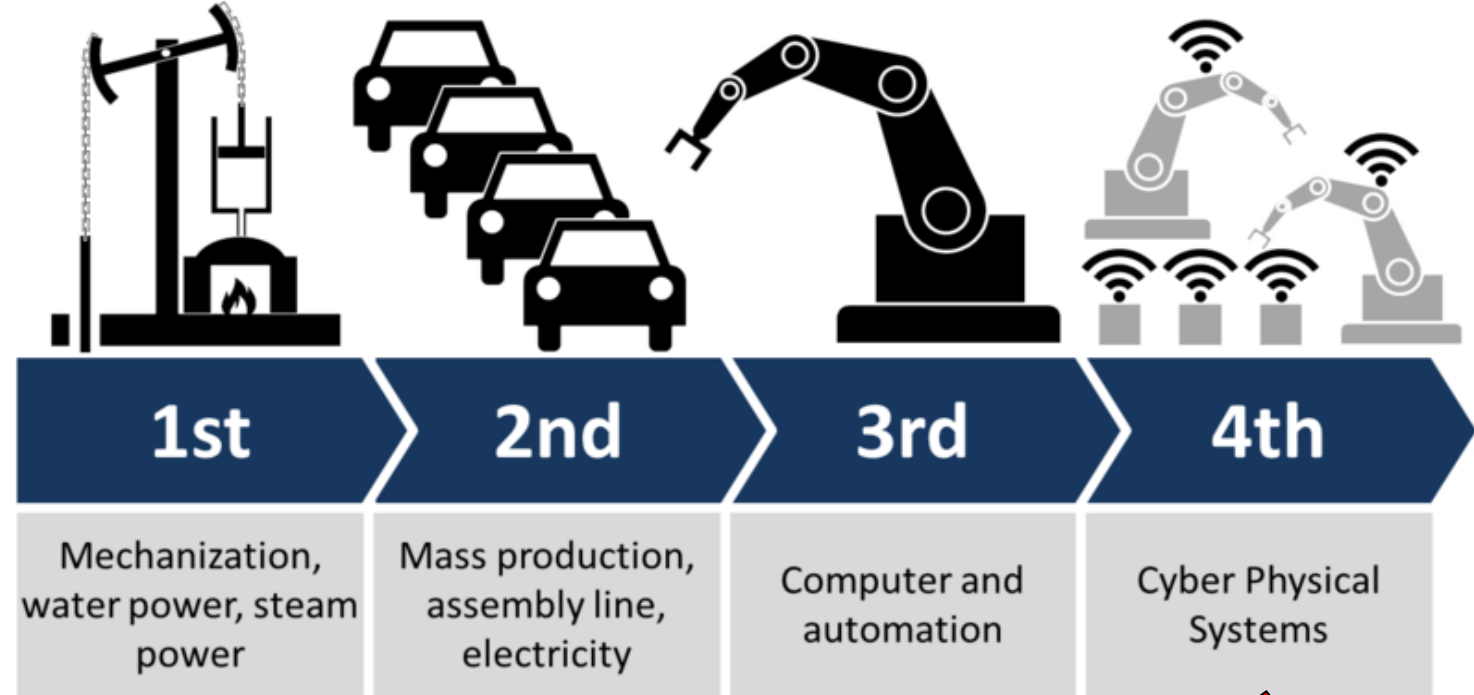

- Software, App / IOS developers: Huge boom in market pre and post lockdown
- Artisans: personal grooming services (high street boom) & specialist products

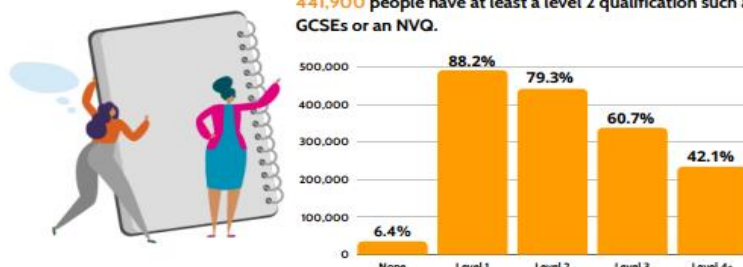

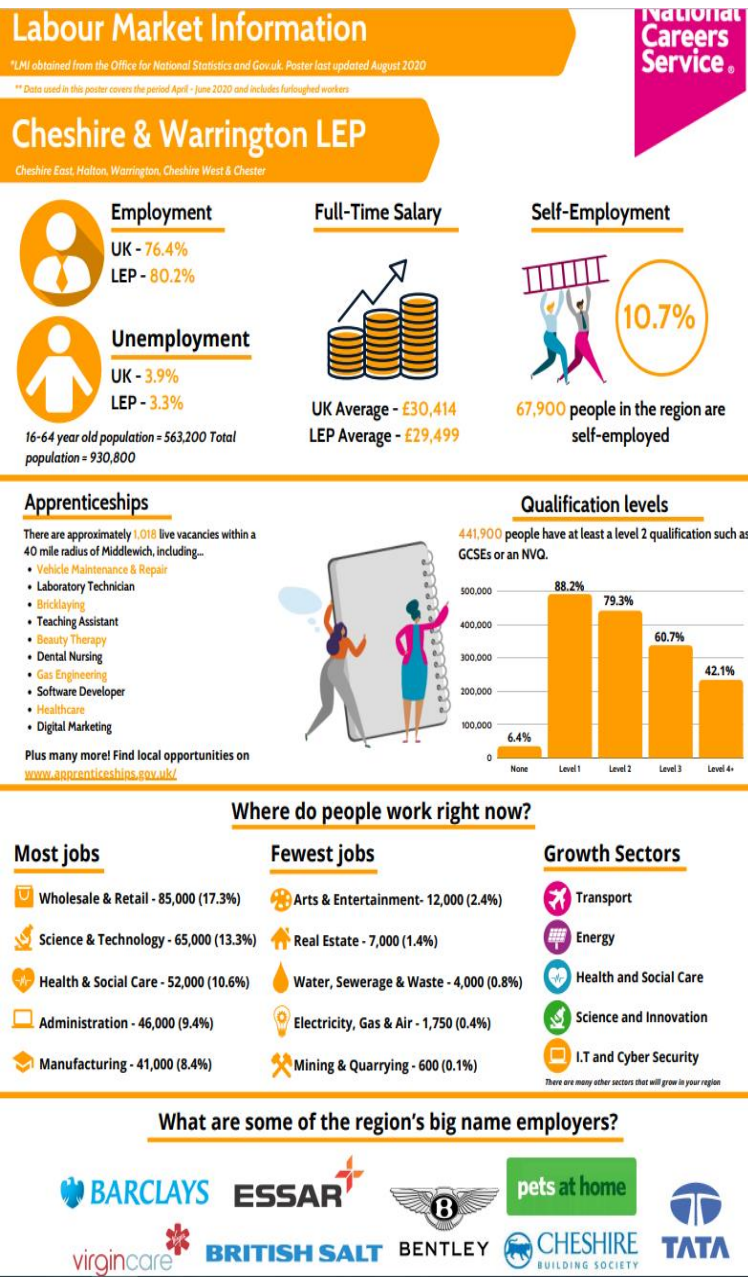

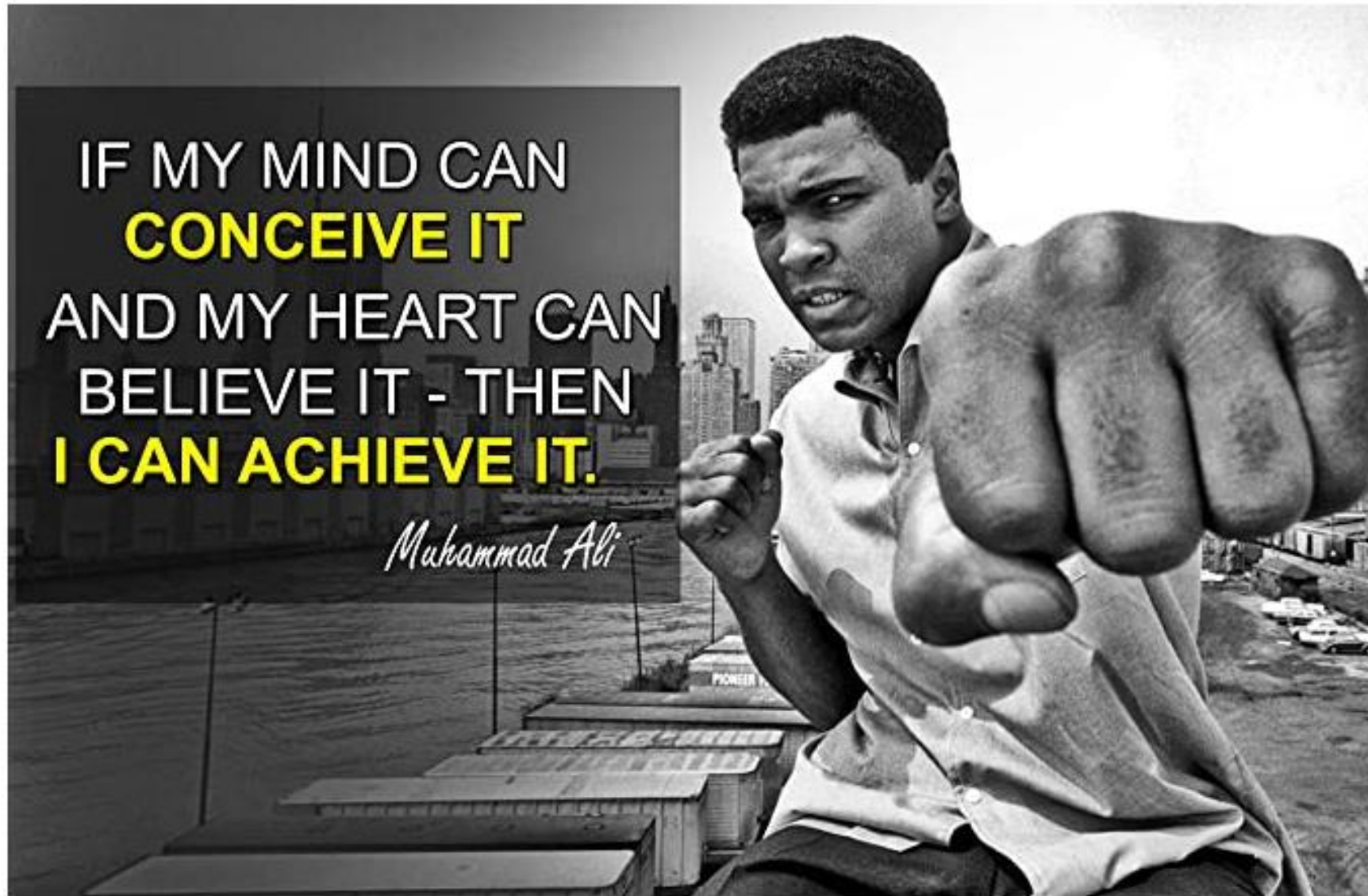
Future-
