Dear Year 11 pupils,

On behalf of all your teachers, support staff, tutors, Mrs Gate, Mrs Baker and Mrs Lightfoot, I wanted to write to wish you all the very best as you commence your GCSE examinations. We have all been immensely proud of how you have navigated your way through your Weaverham experience. We are so very proud of how you have contributed to and helped to shape our community.

You are ready for your examinations. Have a positive mindset about your capabilities and what you can achieve with determination and hard work. Strive to do your best – that is all anyone can ask of you. **Your best is *always* good enough.**

Over the Easter break, balance your time between revision, rest and participating in activities that make you feel positive.

Feel excited about the doors your results will open for you. You've got this. We are here to support, encourage, guide and help with those last-minute nerves. Let us know if you need more help.

When we return from the Easter break, we will share with you the plans for your final assembly and our Year 11 prom. Both of these events will be moments of celebration that you deserve and you will remember.

Before we get to that point, a gentle reminder of the processes that we all must be aware of in preparation for your first examination. The link below will take you to the section of the website that has all the necessary information you need regarding exam expectations. **All the key messages will be shared in your assembly this half term – remember, once an examination has commenced, pupils are not allowed to enter the examination hall or room.** It is really important that you arrive to school on time, fully prepared. Some key reminders:

- The school day remains the same as it has been all year. You **MUST** be in school at 8.30am for a prompt start to period 1
- If you have a morning exam the period 1 session will be a pre-exam revision session led by a specialist teacher.
- If you don't have a morning exam you **MUST** go to lessons as per your timetable.
- If you have an afternoon exam, there will be a pre-exam revision session the hour before.



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- Details of all pre-exam sessions will be on your Goggle Classroom area for each subject.
- As the exam season gets underway and you complete all examinations in a certain subject, you will be expected to bring relevant revision material for the remaining exams. You will still continue to follow your usual timetable and will have independent study time.
- Subject specialist may arrange additional subject sessions and you will be informed of this nearer the time.
- Your timetable will continue as usual throughout the exam period. When you have completed all exams in a particular subject. You will be expected to take revision material into your timetabled lessons for independent study. Your official last day of Year 11 will be Friday 22nd May 2026.
- You will need to wear full school uniform including tie and school jumper – these are JCQ rules and we must adhere to them.
- Wed 24th June is the national GCSE exam contingency date. This is a backup exam date which all schools must include in the official exam timetable. Exam boards add this day at the end of the exam period as a precaution. In most years, students will not need to use it. The contingency day only becomes relevant if an exam cannot take place as planned.
