Ofsted has confirmed that our school meets either the 'Strong' or 'Expected' standard in all categories. This achievement reflects our ambitious and inclusive culture, alongside the high academic expectations that are delivering outcomes for our pupils above the national average.

I am absolutely delighted. This outcome captures the ambitious and inclusive school we are and reflects our commitment to fulfilling our vision of how our school changes the life chances of our remarkable young people. We fully embraced the changes to school inspections, as this framework provides greater clarity for you as parents and a more rigorous assessment of our performance. We are thrilled that inspectors confirmed Strong and Expected practices that reflect the highly impactful work we have embedded across our school.

The inspectors highlighted our positive and inclusive culture, stating: "Pupils are seen and heard. They know that they matter." In particular, they praised our commitment to inclusion, noting it "lies at the heart of leaders' work," and described our approach to careers education as the "lifeblood of the school."

As a leadership team, we feel the written report captures our school well. We see your children as the unique individuals they are and work tirelessly to ensure they are given the opportunities they need to be the leaders of tomorrow and secure the future they deserve.

Our pupils' conduct and behaviour were a further highlight. Inspectors commented that we are ambitious for all of them and aim to instil an 'ethic of excellence' that will unlock each student's unique potential. They respond to challenges with eagerness, and lessons are focused on learning and free from disruption.

I am incredibly proud that the inspectors saw what we see every day: proud, hard-working young people who take every opportunity to be the very best version of themselves. Our young people benefit from a calm, purposeful learning atmosphere underpinned by mutual respect.

The report also recognises the strength of pupil development across the school and acknowledges how it links to our aspirational culture. Our pupils appreciate the extensive and exciting range of opportunities to support their personal development and character. Student leadership was identified as a particular strength, with our pupils gaining confidence and a sense of service through meaningful roles, such as Ethos Leaders.
